





UNIVERSITY TRANSFER OPTIONS

As the fastest growing community college in California, we make transfer to the University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) systems a simple process for our students. International students can also transfer to other public and private universities throughout the United States by first completing two years of study at our community college.

How does it work?

Students complete year 1 and 2 general education and foundation courses at COD, and transfer this coursework to a university. After completing year 3 and 4 at the university, students obtain their Bachelor's degree. There is no difference in the Bachelor's degree whether you do all four years at the university or complete the first two years at a community college.

The main difference is the tremendous cost savings you have by choosing a community college first and an opportunity to enter prestigious universities throughout the U.S. For some students, this 2+2 Bachelor's degree pathway saves them over \$120,000!

HOW DO I APPLY TO COD AND THE IEA?

Application to College of the Desert and the Intensive English Academy is easy. Just follow these steps:

1. Download the International Student Application at www.collegeofthedesert.edu/international. You can use the same application for both College of the Desert and the Intensive English Academy.
2. Submit all required documents simply by uploading copies into the applicaiton form.

College of the Desert admits students on a rolling basis, so we do not have set application deadlines.

Our International admission staff provides continuous support to our applicants, and we're happy to talk with you by Messenger or Skype to assist you with the process.

College of the Desert is authorized to issue I-20 forms for full-time study. Upon acceptance, students will receive an acceptance letter and the I-20 which can be used to apply for the F-1 visa at the US Embassy in your home country.
