DISCOVER BRIGHTON, THE UK AND EUROPE

Brighton is only a nine-minute train ride from the Sussex campus. It has a truly diverse cultural scene, with plenty of theatres, cinemas and galleries.

Originally made fashionable in the 1780s by the Prince Regent, Brighton has a long history as a popular holiday resort. The Prince (later King George IV) built an extravagant palace, the Royal Pavilion, which now stands at the heart of the city.

Of the many cultural events that take place throughout the year, the highlight is the Brighton Festival in May, England's biggest arts festival. Sussex is also ranked in the top 10 universities in the UK for nightlife owing to its diverse pubs, clubs and music venues (*Which? University Guide* 2018).

Just one hour from central London by train and within easy reach of Gatwick airport, you'll easily be able to explore the rest of the UK and Europe.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The full academic year consists of two semesters comprised of autumn and spring-summer terms, starting in late September and finishing early June. As a visiting and exchange student, you can choose to study for the full year or just one semester.

Students often say that they wish they could stay for longer at Sussex. Studying for a full year means you have more time to immerse yourself in British culture, enjoy weekends away and travel during vacations. It can also be easier to find accommodation.

SUBMITTING YOUR APPLICATION

- Decide how long you wish to study at Sussex and check our entrance requirements.
- Look through the modules listed in subject areas. Give six module choices in order of preference, include alternatives in case your first choices are not available.
- Remember to check in which term they are taught.
- Download the application form and submit the completed form with the relevant documents directly to the Sussex Abroad Office by email or post.
- Application deadlines are 1 April for September entrance; 30 October for January entrance.

IT'S YOUR CHOICE

Among the most exciting things about studying at Sussex is the wide range of modules taught by world-leading academics. Our flexible study abroad programme allows you to choose modules from across different subject areas. Tailor your choices to suit your interests and meet your academic requirements. You will study alongside British and other international students taking full degrees.

Choose your modules from this broad range of subject areas: Accounting and Finance; American Studies; Anthropology; Art History; Biology, Biochemistry and Biomedical Science; Business, Management and Marketing; Chemistry; Computing and Digital Media; Criminology; Ecology, Conservation and Environment; Economics; Education, Childhood and Youth; Engineering and Design; English and Drama; Genetics; Geography; History; International Development; International Relations; Languages; Law; Mathematics; Media, Communications and Film; Music; Neuroscience; Philosophy; Physics and Astronomy; Politics; Psychology; Social Work, Wellbeing and Social Care; Sociology; Zoology.

ACADEMIC AND LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

You must be academically qualified to take the modules for which you apply and are normally expected to have completed at least one year of higher education in your own country. We require students to have a minimum of 2.8 GPA out of 4 or equivalent.

If English is not your native language, you must demonstrate a good level of English competence and provide evidence of suitable English language qualifications.
