Receive support for understanding and completing your university course assignments. Improve your English and academic skills for university success. Gateway can be repeated a maximum of two consecutive terms.

- Enrollment in one or two SF State courses for credit
- Conditional Admission to SF State for eligible students
- Advisors help you apply to SF State and assist with visa questions and cultural adjustments

- Merit Scholarships available for qualified students
- Living in San Francisco (A U 110) course (free) introduces history, culture and neighborhoods with field trips







GATEWAY REQUIREMENTS

New Students:

Direct admission with minimum score of TOEFL iBT 61 or IELTS 6.0
OR • Admission based on EAP level placement speaking and within last 24 months

Level 70 Students:

Must pass EAP Level 70 classes with a B average + minimum TOEFL ITP* 475, TOEFL iBT 53

Level 80 Students:

• Must pass EAP Level 80 classes with A, B or C grade. There is **NO** TOEFL or IELTS score requirement.
